This grant normally amounts £400, but was reduced to £252 in the year ending 31 March 2021, because the Lengthsman failed to provide the necessary evidence of work done during year ended 31 March 2020.

The Parish Council installed a defibrillator in the village during the year ended 31 March 2015. The Parish Council resolved on 29 September 2018 to assist in funding the costs of maintaining of this equipment. The COVID-19 restrictions prevented any fund raising for the defibrillator during the year ended 31 March 2021.

When a cheque payment was issued on 21 May 2020, the Lengthsman failed to present the cheque. A replacement cheque was issued and presented during the year ended 31 March 2022.

The Lengthsman is now contracted to undertake work to the value of  $\pounds 400$  per year to match the grant received by the Parish Council from the Staffordshire Moorlands District Council. The Parish Council delayed payment for the Lengthsman for the year ended 31 March 2022, because he failed to provide the necessary evidence of work done during that year.
